

Addendum to your Blue Medicare Advantage 2023 Annual Notice of Changes (ANOC), Evidence of Coverage (EOC), and Summary of Benefits (SB) documents

Dear Member,

As a Blue Medicare Advantage member, we want to keep you informed about important changes to your Medicare Advantage plan that will become effective during the year.

Due to the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA), there have been additional benefit changes effective later this year. The information below may or may not apply to you, but we are required to notify you of these changes.

Benefit	Effective Date	Benefit Changes	What does this mean for you?
Medicare Part B Prescription Drugs	April 1, 2023	The cost-sharing for certain Medicare Part B Prescription Drugs may be subject to a lower coinsurance than what is listed in your member documents.	The cost-sharing for certain Part B drugs could be less.
Part B Insulin through an item of durable medical equipment (i.e., a medically necessary traditional insulin pump)	July 1, 2023	The cost-sharing for a one-month supply of this insulin would be no more than \$35. If the plan has a deductible, it would not apply to this insulin.	If you're diabetic and on an insulin pump, the cost of the insulin used through the pump would be no more than \$35 for a one-month's supply

You are not required to take any action in response to this document, but we recommend you keep this information for future reference.
